Exhibit space prices start at \$995 for a 6 foot x 6 foot Junior Booth and range upwards according to size and

Q *What about Booth Reps?*

A Exhibiting companies may purchase badges for representatives (Booth Reps) who require unlimited access to the exhibit hall only.

Booth Rep Fees are \$150 each if staying at the Forum Hotel (\$430 if staying at a Non-Forum Hotel). Booth Reps are admitted to the Exhibit Hall Only and entitled to food and beverage items served in the exhibit area. An NDTA badge must be worn at all times.

Q *What is the Booth Cancellation Policy?*

A A written request for cancellation of exhibit space is required by August 28, 2009, which will incur a \$200 processing fee. Exhibitors canceling after August 28, 2009 will be charged 100% of the cost of the space. Q *What are the Forum Hotel Room Rates?*

Q *What is the Hotel cancellation policy?*

A Cancellations must be received 72 hours prior to your arrival date to avoid a cancellation fee equivalent to the first night's room and tax.
